#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. On Sunday 11 June, the society will visit Portlaoise where a guided tour will be conducted of the extensive remains of Fort Protector (the fort of Maryborough). We shall then proceed to the Pass of the Plumes, the site of the action in 1599 in which Owny MacRory O'More opposed the army of the earl of Essex, followed by a visit to the Rock of Dunamase.
