3. Coach: The engaging of a coach will depend on there being sufficient demand. The cost per person is \in 35. Those travelling by coach may park their cars in Cathal Brugha Barracks provided that car registration numbers are included on the application form. (Based on AA website, the cost of petrol for a car would be in the region of €63 return from Dublin).

- 4. Private cars: For those travelling in private cars, the rendezvous will be: Dundrum Castle (north of Newcastle, Co Down) on **Sunday** at 11.45hrs; and at HMS Caroline on **Monday** at 09.45hrs.
- 5. Accommodation: The Society has booked a limited number of rooms at The Strangford Arms Hotel at a discounted price. The cost is BP£60 per person sharing in double room for one night bed and breakfast and a communal dinner. Rates per person, including communal dinner, for Single room is BP£85.

¹ Dundrum Castle is on a hill and there is a steep walk up from the car park which may not suit everyone. However, there are picnic tables in the car park. Also, the information booth may be open.

² Note that there are steep stairs, trip hazards, low ceilings, narrow & low doorways, decks can be slippery when wet, low light levels and uneven surfaces on board the ship.

Rooms held for the MHSI at the discounted price will be released by the hotel on 20th April to the general public at normal rates, if not already booked by members of the Society.
